

Safety Requirements to for ET breakdown.

All vehicles must have:

Good tires, a solid battery hold down, radiator overflow reservoir, functioning neutral-safety switch, seat belts.

All drivers must have:

A valid state driver's license or NHRA competition license and driver must wear long pants, a shirt, and closed toe shoes.

When required by ET or Speed:

Helmet must meet requirements of one of the following M2010, M2015, SA2010 or SA2015 certification.

- Tag will be located inside helmet under the liner. **No exceptions will be made!**
- New helmets and/or safety gear, will be for sale in our manufacture midway (as supplies last).

For every ET breakdown:

All slower ET requirements must be met. Example, if your vehicle runs 10.99, you must have all required equipment for the 13.99, 13.49 & 11.49 as well as the 10.99 requirements.

13.99 seconds (8.59 1/8th)

- Helmet Required, must meet requirements of one of the following M2015, M2020
 - Tag will be located inside helmet under the liner. **No Exceptions Made!**
- SFI 3.2A/1 Jacket in vehicles equipped with non-OEM nitrous oxide, turbochargers or superchargers

11.49 seconds (7.35 1/8th)

- SFI 3.2A/1 approved jacket (single layer)
- Roll bar
- SFI approved seat belts

9.99 seconds (6.39 1/8th) or 135 mph

- NHRA Chassis Certification
- NHRA Competition License
- SFI Jacket & Pants 3.2A/5 (multi-layer)
- SFI Neck Collar & Gloves 3.3/1
- Full Face Helmet meeting Snell 2010 or later
- Parachute at 150 MPH
